## DAY 1: MANILA - TAOYUAN (/--/D)

Check in NAIA, 3 hours before departure. Upon arrival at Taoyuan International airport, meet and greet, then transfer to **Taipei 101 (Observatory ticket not included)** and have dinner. Free time shopping at **Shilin Market**. After tour, transfer to hotel for check in.

## DAY 2: NEW TAIPEI - TAIPEI (B/L/D)

After breakfast inside hotel, head to **Pitou Cape** - one of the Three Capes of Taiwan, a breath taking scenic view at the top of the cape awaits you. Pass by the **Chinkuashih Village**. Have lunch then transfer to **Chiufen Village**, used to be a gold mining center of Taiwan, is now a bustling district known for its narrow streets, food stalls, and sweeping views of the mountains and sea. Experience the **Sky Lantern Festival** of the city. Have dinner and check in at the hotel.

## DAY 3: TAIPEI (B/--/--)

After breakfast inside the hotel, free time at your own leisure. (No guide and no driver)

## DAY 4: TAIPEI CITY TOUR - DEPARTURE (B/L/--)

After breakfast inside the hotel, experience making a **Pineapple cake** and proceed to Taipei and visit to **Chang Kai Shek Memorial Hall**. Transfer to airport for departure.
